

Privacy Policy

Effective January 1, 2023

CytoCan (“CytoCan”, “we”, “us” or “our”) is committed to protecting the privacy of your information. This Privacy Policy (“Policy”) describes the information collection and dissemination practices in connection with this website. This Policy does not address personal information provided to us that is not handled through this website.

By accessing our website, you agree to be bound by this Policy. If you do not agree, please do not use this website.

Personal Information You Provide

We collect information that you voluntarily provide when you use this website. For example, you might provide us with your name, age, birth date, gender, phone number, email address, and other personal information when you register an online account, apply for a job, or participate in an online survey through this website. We will use your personal information to address your request for information, products, or services from us, but we will not sell, rent, license, or trade your personal information with third parties unless we receive your express consent to do so.

We may share your personal information under confidentiality agreements with other companies that work with, or on behalf of us to provide the products and services you are requesting. These companies, which may include members of our corporate family, may use your personal information to assist us in our operations. However, these companies do not have any independent right to share your information.

Under certain circumstances we may provide information about you to respond to subpoenas, court orders, legal processes, or governmental regulations, or to establish or exercise our legal rights or defend against legal claims.

We may share your personal information with other business entities, in connection with the sale, assignment, merger or other transfer of all or a portion of our business to such business entity. We will require any such successor business entity to honor the terms of this Privacy Policy.

Aggregate Information Collected

Aggregate Information is information that does not identify you. Aggregate Information may be collected when you use our website, independent of any information you voluntarily enter. We may collect, use, store, and transfer Aggregate Information without restriction.

For example, when you visit our website, some information might be automatically collected, such as your operating system, location, a web site from which you linked to us, the website you choose to visit immediately after ours, your browser type, language, device identifier numbers, site activity, and the time and date of your visit.

Aggregate Information may be used for internal reporting and for the analysis of our website traffic. Such anonymous, group data may be shared on an aggregated basis with our affiliates, business partners, service providers and/or vendors.

IP Address

IP Address is a number that is automatically assigned to the computer that a user is using by the user's Internet Service Provider. An IP Address may be identified and logged automatically in our server log files whenever a user accesses our website, along with the time of the visit and the page(s) visited. Collecting IP Addresses is standard practice and is done automatically by many websites. We may use IP Addresses for purposes such as calculating usage levels, helping diagnose server problems, and the administration.

Cookies

Cookies are small blocks of data created by a web server while a user is browsing a website and placed on the user's computer storing information about a user's preferences. Though not personally identify users, cookies do identify a user's computer. Like many websites using cookies as a standard practice to provide useful features, we may use cookies to improve online experience. Cookies allow us to recognize you and personalize your experience, to facilitate navigation, and to display information more effectively. By modifying user's browser preferences (see <http://www.allaboutcookies.org/manage-cookies/index.html>), a user has the option to accept all cookies, to be notified when a cookie is set, or to reject all cookies. You have full freedom to choose an option you prefer, even though disabling cookies may disable certain features of our website.

We may work with third-party analytics providers to collect and process cookies, pixels, or beacons to track the traffic patterns of users from one web page to another to maximize web traffic flow, and/or analyze the effectiveness of our website.

Children and Privacy

The website is not designed for, or intentionally targeted at, children 13 years of age or younger. A person under the age of 13 shall refrain from using our website and shall NOT submit any personal information to the website. Therefore, if someone does so, we do not knowingly collect personal information from children in connection with this website.
